There are three headlines modules available:

Headlines Module

Headlines 2x Module

Headlines 3x Module

Each module can be added or removed from the homepage using the module controls, and since each displays its own separate set of articles, all three can be used together to show different content at the same time.

The **Headlines module** displays an unlimited number of articles in a vertical listing with one article per line, making it a good fit for a straightforward list where each headline stands out on its own.

The **Headlines 2x module** also displays an unlimited number of articles vertically, but with two articles per line, similar to a two-column newspaper format. This is useful for showcasing more content while still keeping a clean, organized look.



Set a secure admin password

The first thing to do when you initially login as the administrator is set a secure password for the account. Click the User Settings button from the home page, then scroll down to the bottom of the page. You will see a password field. Delete the current password and enter in your own private password.



The administration area

The Administration Area is the main control panel for the UnionActive system. To access the Administration Area, login to the website as an administrator, and then click the Admin Area button just below the website date. Each link in the Administration Area has a short description about what can be done in that area.

The **Headlines 3x module** displays exactly three articles side by side in a single row, creating a three-column layout. This works well for highlighting specific articles or news items you want to feature prominently on the homepage.

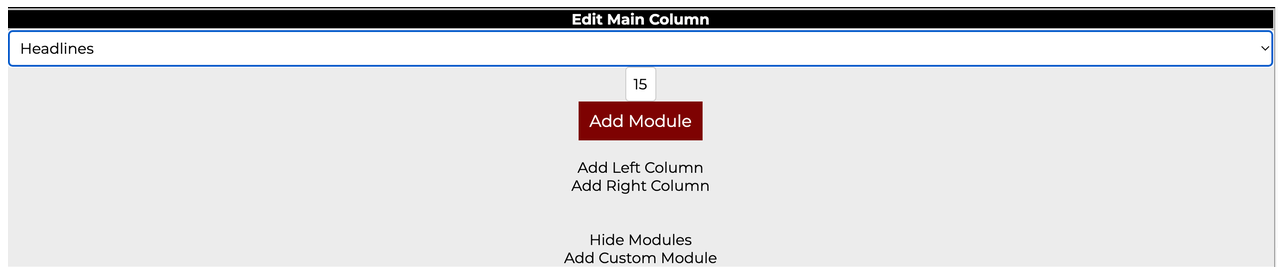

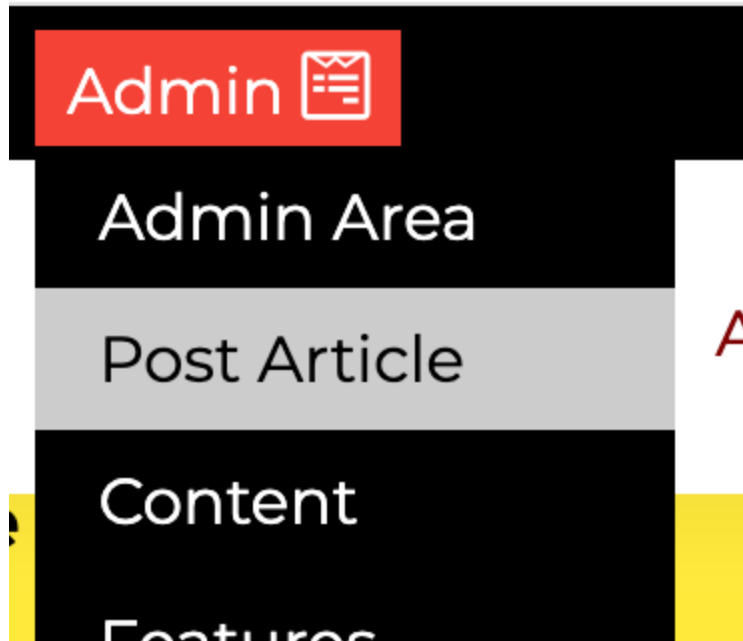
Adding Modules and Headlines

You can select any of the three headline modules from the module selector:



You can add headlines either by selecting Post Article from the headlines module or by going directly to Post Article from the Admin Area and selecting the module you would like to add articles to:

Post Article



You can do this by selecting the relevant headline module under the Select Article Page dropdown:



Use this form to post articles to the web site. Once you post an article, it will be available for users to read. You can delete articles by going to the page and clicking the delete button next to the article you want to remove. If your article has images embedded in it you will need to upload the images in the [File & Image Manager](#) area.

Just like with other articles, you can add titles, content, files, attachments, or caption images. At the very least, a title must be included for the Menu Title. A Full Page Title is optional, and if you do not include it, the Menu Title will be used instead.
