What if I don't want my content posted to the newswire?

When you post an article to the "What's New" section or a headline module while also restricting access to a resource group, the article will not be shared with the IAFF Newswire. The IAFF Newswire only includes content that is publicly accessible.

Articles that posted to other sections, such as Member Home, any other pages on the site, are not included in the newswire.

Include articles in the IAFF Newswire

To include articles in the IAFF Newswire, you'll need to post them as "What's New" articles on your UnionActive website. Here's a step-by-step guide on how to do this:

1. **Log into the Admin Area:** Start by logging into your UnionActive website with your admin account.
2. **Navigate to the Content Tab:** Once logged in, go to the **Content Tab** in the admin area.

3. **Access Main Menu Pages:** Click on **Main Menu Pages** to find the option for posting articles.
4. **Post Articles:** Click on the **Post Articles** button.
5. **Select Article Type:** Choose the **Custom Content Article** option.
6. **Choose Article Page:** Leave the "Select Article Page" option as **What's New**. This is crucial for the article to be included in the IAFF Newswire.
7. **Enter Article Details:**
 8. - **Title:** Enter a title for your article in the menu title field.
 9. - **Content:** Fill in the content of your article in the text editor box.
 10. - **Optional:** You can also add a caption image or attachment file if desired.
11. **Post the Article:** Click the **Post Article** button at the bottom of the page to save your article.
12. **Verify Posting:** After posting, you can check the homepage to ensure that the article appears in the "What's New" section.

IBEW Newswire, Police Newswire

Sites that are on Union Active but are IBEW sites will have the IBEW Newswire module instead of the IAFF Newswire modules. Similarly, Union Active Police sites have access to a Police Newswire module. Otherwise these modules function exactly the same as the IAFF Newswire.
