

Image Rotator

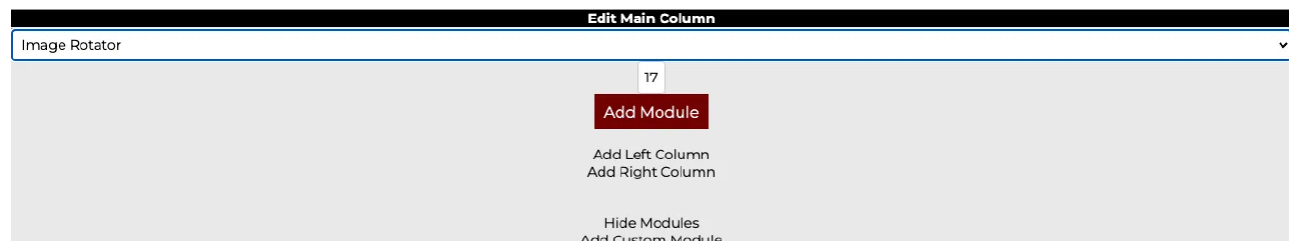
The Image Rotator module allows you to display a series of images in a rotating format on your website, making it a great option for showcasing announcements, events, or other content you want to highlight visually. The module has been redesigned without Flash, meaning it works in any browser, including on iPhones and iPads, and is fully responsive across desktops, tablets, and smartphones.

Why Use the Image Rotator?

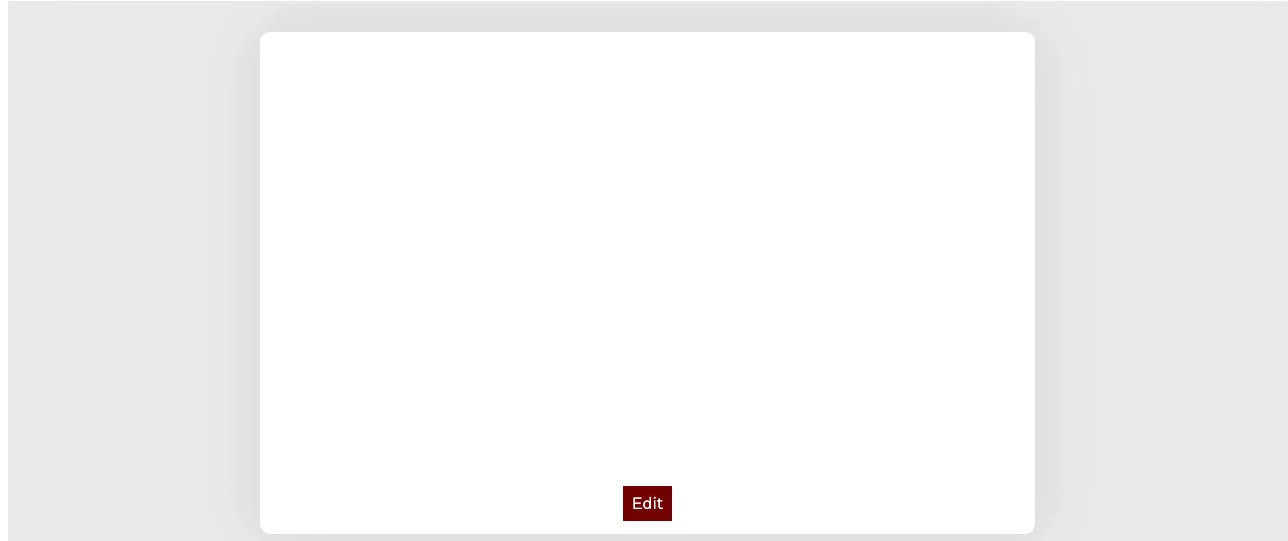
The Image Rotator is a simple but effective way to make your website feel more dynamic. Rotating images naturally draw the eye and encourage visitors to engage with your content, without requiring them to click through to a separate page. Because the module is fully responsive, it looks great whether your members are visiting on a desktop, tablet, or smartphone. And since managing the images doesn't require any advanced technical skills, anyone with access to the admin area can keep the content up to date.

Setting Up the Image Rotator Module

To add the Image Rotator to your homepage, navigate to Edit Main Column, select Image Rotator from the dropdown menu, and click Add Module.



Once added, the module will appear on the page with an Edit button, which you can use to manage its content and settings.



Clicking edit will open the Manage Flash Image Rotator:

Before adding images, first set your preferred width and height for the rotator, then click Save. It's worth getting this right before you start adding images, as changing the size afterward will require you to re-add all of your images for them to display correctly.

To add a new image, click Choose File and select an image from your computer. Each image has several optional fields you can fill in:

Title and Description: These appear as a text overlay directly on the image, with the title in bold and the description beneath it. If you leave these fields blank, the image will display without any overlay.

Link URL and Link Target: If you want the image to be clickable, enter a URL and choose whether it opens in the same window or a new one.

Text Position: Controls where the overlay text appears on the image, measured in x and y pixels from the top left corner of the banner.

Order: Controls the sequence in which the images rotate. Once you've added your images, they will be listed under Current Banner Images along with their thumbnails and descriptions, numbered according to the order you've set.



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Click Add Image to save each entry. All images can be edited or removed at any time by clicking the Edit or Remove buttons next to each image in the Current Banner Images list.
